The Government of Uganda represented by the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Development (MEMD) has received funds from the German Financial Cooperation via KfW for the “Get Access Uganda - Support to Mini-grids” programme (BMZ No 2017.67.904) and intends to apply part of the proceeds of these funds towards the cost for the procurement to **Develop, Finance, Implement and Maintain Mini-Grids in Northern, Central and Eastern Regions of Uganda Under Public Private Partnership (PPP).**

The MEMD now invites suitably qualified applicants to submit sealed shortlisting submissions for this tender. The prequalification for developers will be implemented in accordance with the Public Private Partnership Act, 2015 and its attendant Regulation of 2019 and KfW “Guidelines for Procurement Guidelines for the Procurement of Consulting Services, Works, Plant, Goods and Non-Consulting Services in Financial Cooperation with Partners” (2021).

Shortlisting is open to all eligible applicants. The maximum number of shortlisted applicants is ten (10).
